## Tuition Payment & Enrollment Information:

- Annual Tuition: \$660 - Includes Registration, book fees & all supplies  
*Does not include out of school functions, such as HS Shabbat dinners and Holiday celebrations*
- Tuition can be paid in one \$660 installment or in 10 monthly payments of \$66 (August-May)
- All checks/credit card payments should please be submitted before or on the first day of Hebrew School.
- Please include a minimum of \$50 together with your application as a deposit (to be deducted from your tuition) to secure a space for your child.
- Checks can be made payable to: Chabad of the Tri-Valley
- Credit Card information can be submitted online or by calling our office.
- Enrollment and acceptance in the Chabad Hebrew School is no way a validation of one's status as a Jew.

# INFORMATION

## Curriculum:

### **Ages 4 & 5 (Pre-K & Kindergarten)**

Our program is designed to grab a child's attention with song, art, drama, and games. By exposure to the aleph-bet, Torah tales, Jewish songs, and day-to-day mitzvot, a child gains a sense of pride and love for the Hebrew language and Judaism. While creating their own set of Holiday puppets, the children will explore each holiday in an exciting and interactive way and learn the basic mitzvot of the Torah and Jewish behaviors with our popular "Mitzvot I can Do" and "Midot I can Do" curriculums.

### **1st Grade Class**

Our first grade students learn the foundations of the Hebrew language with our acclaimed Aleph Champ motivational program, study the Torah (portion by portion starting from Genesis), and prepare for each Jewish holiday. Interactive and age appropriate challenging lessons make the core values of our faith and basic Hebrew skills come alive.

### **2nd Grade Class**

Our second grade offers a more advanced Hebrew and Judaic studies curriculum. In addition to the Aleph Champ motivational system and the celebration of Jewish Holidays, our specialized age-appropriate Torah curriculum takes the students through the 2nd book of the Torah, the book of Shemot/Exodus in an interactive and comprehensive way.

### **3rd Grade Class**

Our third grade class enters the world of "My Jewish Home", a specialized curriculum that travels through essential mitzvahs and Jewish values. Additionally, our students will continue to master the Aleph Champ Hebrew reading program and of course, learn the Jewish holidays with our exciting "Holiday Flashcard" program.

## **4<sup>th</sup> Grade Class**

In addition to a more advanced learning of the holidays, our 4th grade students will delve into the world of Jewish Heroes (incorporating the stories of the Tanach; the 24 books of the Torah), meeting, understanding and relating to the many Jewish Heroes throughout our rich history. Students will continue Aleph Champ and upon mastering the reading program, will move on to writing and language development.

## **5<sup>th</sup> Grade Class**

Our 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will explore Jewish Lifecycles. They will each “give birth” to a baby boy and girl and travel through their children’s brit, baby naming, pidyon haben, childhood, Bar/Bat Mitzvah, teen years, wedding, and end of life. Parents, you may receive an invitation to join us for some of these celebrations!

## **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Girls**

Our 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will explore Jewish Lifecycles. They will each “give birth” to a baby boy and girl and travel through their children’s brit, baby naming, pidyon haben, childhood, Bar/Bat Mitzvah, teen years, wedding, and end of life. ## **Bar Mitzvah Discovery Course – 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Boys**

Students meet with the Rabbi for breakfast, learn how to don Tefillin in prayer, and are engaged with in-depth discussions on Jewish fundamentals. Units include: The timeline of Jewish history, Death & the Afterlife, Science and Religion, being a Jew in today’s modern world, the belief in Moshiach (messiah) – among other units.
