Prek - Kindergarten

This first taste of Hebrew school is filled with games, crafts and endless joy as we explore the basic mitzvoth of the Torah with our popular "Mitzvot I Can Do" program. Each child will bring home an adorable "Mitzvot I Can Do" scrapbook.
